Why Learn ROS?

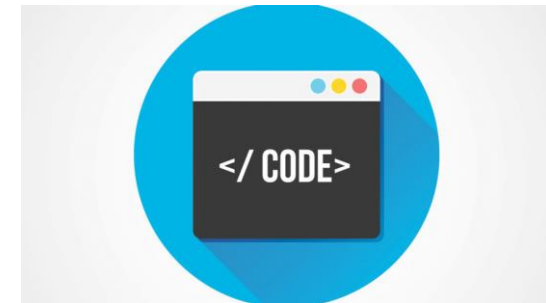
- It's used in robots across different industries
 - Military (ROS-M)
 - Manufacturing (ROS-I)
 - Academia (ROS 1/2)
- Modular design
 - Easy to reuse code in various projects
 - Easy to add/change functionality (Rapid Prototyping)
- Distributed Computation
 - Can run across multiple computers and robots

 - Communication Middleware Layer

Install ROS

- For every version of Ubuntu there is a version of ROS made specifically for it.
 - For Ubuntu 16.04 use ROS Kinetic
 - For Ubuntu 18.04 use ROS Melodic
